

Student Teaching: Fall 2008

Assignments for student teaching, that have been confirmed, will be distributed **AFTER** May 20, 2008. This will occur via email. Do not inquire about your placement prior to this. College Supervisors will be assigned and they will contact you, after this or when they receive your assignment, and arrange to meet you and forward your assignment.

JUNE, 2008-Make an appointment, prior to the closing of school, to meet the first Associate Teacher you have been assigned to; try to acquire a handbook from the school, also. Advise me of any concerns or changes in your assignment.
