

Eligible Health Care Reimbursement Expenses

Eligible expenses include medical, dental and vision expenses for services incurred during the plan year for the diagnosis, treatment or prevention of disease. Any qualified health care expenses are eligible for reimbursement as long as your group health plan has not already covered the expenses and as long as the Internal Revenue Service continues to allow. Services performed solely for cosmetic reasons generally are not eligible.

- Funeral expenses
- Food for weight loss programs
- General health and personal use over-the-counter items (including health and beauty aids, vitamins, nutritional supplements for general well being, cosmetics)*
- Teeth whitening
- Diaper service
- Health and beauty aids
- Insurance premiums
