



Your guide to Blackboard(Bb) Learning

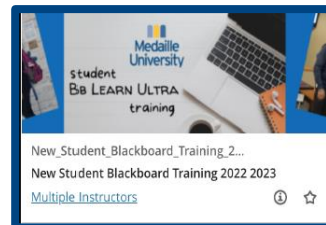
We have a terrific opportunity for you to learn about the Anthology Blackboard (Bb) learning management system that your instructors will be using to supplement in-class instruction. Blackboard is a learning management system for your courses like Google Classroom or Schoology, that many of you used during your high school classes.

We have designed a new student Blackboard (Bb) training that will help you learn how to navigate Blackboard and complete common tasks like uploading an assignment, participating in a discussion, taking a quiz and locating grades and instructor feedback.

Prior to participating in the new student Blackboard training, you will need to do the following:

1. Pick up your **Medaille account**, so you have your username and password.
2. Watch the **New Student Orientation Logging on to Blackboard video** to learn about the logon process and tool features of the Bb course menu.
3. Watch the **Navigating Bb Courses** video to learn how to navigate the training.
4. Visit **Medaille Connect** and sign in with your Medaille user ID and password.
5. Scroll to the bottom of the Medaille360 for Students page and click on **Blackboard**. If prompted, click on the Sign in with Medaille Connect button.
6. Click on the **Courses** link, found on the menu on the left side, then choose the **New Student Blackboard Training UGTR 2022 2023** link or tile (depending on the course listing pageview) to get started.
