

Attention UG Transfer Students!

The Registrar's Office is here to help you succeed!

Evaluation Process:

- We accept transfer credits from all regionally accredited colleges/universities and those institutions registered by the New York State Education Department to grant degrees.
- The Registrar's Office completes a transfer credit evaluation when we have official transcripts from all colleges/universities an incoming transfer student has attended.
- Transferability works best when transferring from like programs or general programs to other like programs (i.e.-Criminal Justice to Criminal Justice or Sport Management to Sport Management)
- We transfer credits, NOT grades. Transfer students begin with a new cumulative average. We do look at your grades when evaluating potential transfer credits. We require at least 'C' grades and 2.0 GPA.
- We will accept up to 12 credits of 'D' grades in either liberal arts and science or free electives provided the overall average of transfer credits is at least 2.0 GPA.
- We accept 'S' and 'P' grades from other institutions.
- The final 15 credits of coursework toward an associate degree must be completed at Medaille
- The final 30 credits of coursework toward a baccalaureate degree must be completed at Medaille

Maximum Transfer Credits Accepted:

<u>FROM</u>	<u>TO</u>
Four year college	- 90 credits toward a baccalaureate degree at Medaille
Two year college	- 72 credits toward a baccalaureate degree at Medaille
Any college	- 45 credits toward an associate degree at Medaille
Combination	- 72 credits from a community college (2 yr) plus 18 credits from a four year college for a total of 90 transfer credits.
