The following is a guide to the use of program electives to fulfill the mandatory core curriculum requirements at Medaille common to all degree programs.

Note: Students transferring for the mathematics program will take GEN 240. BIO 130-131 will count as LAS transfer credit.

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*Students transferring to Medaille's business administration and sport management programs will be required to take additional mathematics courses at the pre-calculus and above level. However MA 110 will transfer as liberal arts and sciences credit in these programs.

Transfer students will complete twelve core curriculum credits at Medaille:

ENG 200	Analytical Writing (3)
MAT 201	Statistics (3) or MAT 115 (3) [for business and sport management majors]
GEN 410/411	Baccalaureate Capstone I and II or two 300/400-level arts and sciences courses

Degree Program Notes

To maximize the usefulness of transfer credit in fulfilling graduation requirements at Medaille College, students should follow the program-specific guidelines below for use of **Liberal Arts (A.A.)** program electives. The notes also provide information about how Trocaire courses fulfill certain categories of requirements at Medaille.

Students transferring for the **B.S in Biology**: BIO 130 and 131 apply toward the major. PH 201 and PSY 101 count toward LAS credit. All other courses not counted toward the core curriculum transfer as free electives. Students will need to complete a directed study in zoology at Medaille (credits are figured into total).

Students transferring for the B.S. in **Business Administration** should select EC 201 and 202 with their social science electives (credits count toward the major). PH 201, PSY 101, EN 102, MA 110 and BU 106 (use a liberal arts elective). All other courses not counted toward the core curriculum transfer as free electives.

Students transferring for the B.S. in **Business Administration with a Management Information Sciences** concentration should select EC 201 and 202 with their social science electives (credits count toward the major). PH 201, PSY 101, EN 102, MA 110 and BU 106 (use a liberal arts elective) transfer LAS credit. All other courses not counted toward the core curriculum transfer as free electives.

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Students transferring for the B.S. in **Communication** should select SOC 101 with their first semester elective, EC 201 *or* 202 with the social science elective and PH 215 Logic with one liberal arts elective (all three transfer as LAS credits). PSY 101, EN 102, PH 201, and one history elective transfer as LAS credit. Use a free elective to choose any arts and sciences course (counts as LAS credit). All other courses not counted toward the core curriculum transfer as free electives.

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Students transferring for the B.S. in **Criminal Justice** should select SP 101 *or* 102 with one of the liberal arts electives (course will count as LAS credit). PH 201 and PSY 101 transfer as LAS credit. All other courses not counted toward the core curriculum transfer as free electives.

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Students transferring for the B.A. in **English** should use two liberal arts electives and their unrestricted first-year elective to select SPA 101-102 and PH 215 (courses transfer as LAS credits). EN 102 counts toward the major. RES 108 substitutes for PHI 170 (transfers for LAS credit). PSY 101 and PHI 201 transfer as LAS credit. All other courses not counted toward the core curriculum transfer as free electives.

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Students transferring for the B.S. in **mathematics** will receive LAS credit at Medaille for their two history electives, PH 201 and EN 102 and BIO 130-131. All other courses not counted toward the core curriculum transfer as free electives.

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Students transferring for the B.A. in **Psychology** should use their social science electives to take SOC 101 (counts as LAS credit). PSY 101 and PSY 102 count toward the major. PHI 201, RS 108, one history and one liberal arts elective transfer as LAS credit. All other courses not counted toward the core curriculum transfer as free electives.

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Students transferring for the B.S. in **Sport Management** should use select EC 202 with one social science elective and BUS 101 with their undesignated first year elective (credits count toward the major). PSY 101, PH 201, RS 108, PSY 102, and CH 100 transfer as LAS credit. All other courses not counted toward the core curriculum transfer as free electives

Students transferring for the B.S. in **Veterinary Technology** will transfer BIO 130/130L, BIO 131/131 as required LAS courses at Medaille. Students should use their undesignated first semester elective to take CH111/11L (course counts as LAS credit). EN 102 and RS 108 all transfer as LAS credit.

To maximize transfer of LAS credit to Medaille, choose the following: PSY 201 or 205 or SOC 207 (use two social science electives); one of the following EN or PH courses with a liberal arts elective: EN 209, 213, 217, 225, or PH 201.
